

You can spend your Core Consumables budget on Low cost Assistive Technology items, if they are required to maintain funded supports

### **LESS THAN \$1500**

Low Cost AT items are less than \$1500. Electronic devices must cost no more than \$750. If the device is an iPad or tablet, you can spend up to \$600

### **LETTER OF SUPPORT**

A provider must confirm in writing that the AT is necessary to continue supports. The written advice is submitted to NDIA by yourself, or your plan manager

### **MAKE SURE**

- It is the lowest specification that will maintain supports
- You do not already have the item or a suitable item to access supports
- The item has not been funded by another organisation

### **EXCLUSIONS**

- Devices with cellular data
- Apps or software (unless approved in the plan)
- Additional hardware or accessories (other than standard protective cases)
- Warranties, such as Apple Care
